Enhancements

- **TML-405**
TotalMail certified to integrate with SQL 2016, PC*MILER 31, Windows 10, and SQL Native connections (which also correctly indicate timeouts).
- **TML-451**
Forms in D2Link support additional items, most commonly leveraged to approximate LTL workflow.
- **TML-572**
Forms in XRS support editing and canceling scheduled stops.

Resolved issues

- **TML-321**
Omnitracs Hours of Service populated thirty-four hour resets with null values.
- **TML-403**
Skybitz service recorded trailer checkcalls with full GPS descriptions, but on trailer profiles, it truncated descriptions at forty-five characters. Longer entries, particularly those appended with translations to other languages, were incomplete.
- **TML-435**
Position Server recorded checkcalls by legheader number which was not available to trailers.
- **TML-442**
Omnitracs Hours of Service errors when messages grow beyond default limit.
- **TML-443/508**
Messages addressed to any member group sent to full fleet.
- **TML-449**
PeopleNet Trailer Tethering included sparse GPS description with only latitude and longitude.

- **TML-467**
Update Move rippled trailers forward, past events where ripple should stop.
- **TML-473**
Skybitz checkcalls failed on consecutive updates for same trailer.
- **TML-480/530**
Omnitracs Hours of Service synced drivers but blanked out license number and state.
- **TML-486**
Group messages send individual messages to each member. If one member's message failed, that error attached to every subsequent message, regardless its success or failure.
- **TML-492**
Messages stuck in checkout after original removed.
- **TML-505**
PeopleNet outbound messages exceeded size limits.
- **TML-507/510/511/594**
ORBCOMM Trailer Management Service failed to run after exceeding original upper limit of its watermark.
- **TML-514/515/522**
Transaction Agent errored out when attempting to update confirmed time.
- **TML-539**
Freight logic forced unnecessary commodity update.
- **TML-544**
Omnitracs Hours of Service synced drivers with incorrect country and state.
- **TML-549**
Omnitracs poller errored upon initial launch and subsequent auto restarts.
- **TML-568**
Crossdock stops (XDU,XDL) updated stop sequences, throwing off origin/end and shipper/consignee for order.
- **TML-597**
D2Link skewed images of signatures from iOS devices (particularly tablets), rendering them unreadable or entirely off-canvas.
